Biocidal Products Regulation

The Biocidal Products Regulation (BPR, Regulation (EU) 528/2012) concerns the placing on the market and use of biocidal products, which are used to protect humans, animals, materials, or articles against harmful organisms like pests or bacteria, by the action of the active substances contained in the biocidal product. The regulation came into effect in September 2013.

BPR registration currently includes 945 substances on the active substance /product type list displayed in Annex I of the regulation. Harbour Industries has reviewed the active substance list to evaluate the impact of the regulation on the manufacture of fluoropolymer insulated wire and cable. Currently, Harbour Industries does not incorporate any of the listed active substances in its manufacturing processes. Therefore, Harbour's manufactured products are not affected by the BPR regulations.

Harbour Industries will continue to monitor the BPR regulations to ensure our manufactured products are not impacted by this regulation.
