In 2025, Canada implemented the Prohibition of Certain Toxic Substances Regulations (PCTS) which went into effect on June 30, 2026. The PCTS 2025 regulation prohibits the manufacture, use, sale, and import of certain toxic substances, and products containing them. The substances prohibited by these Regulations are some of the most harmful, which were declared toxic to the environment and/or human health under the Canadian Environmental Protection Act, 1999 (CEPA), and are persistent and bioaccumulative. The 2025 regulations are the main tools to implement Canada's obligations for industrial chemicals under the Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants.

The PCTS Regulations only apply to certain toxic substances included on Schedule 1 of CEPA.
